Scholarships Children are considered for scholarship awards based on strong desire, ability, and family support with shows and competitions. Financial need is the consideration in each case. VSOA participates in annual fundraisers for scholarships and receives local sponsors for individual children. Scholarships can be given for a supply / Show fee as well as camps and private lessons. There is a fall semester course fee and a spring semester course that includes weekly semester course 2 hour classes in various mediums, production of paintings, visual art all supplies, show fees, live painting appearances, summer camps, plein air excursions, professional business training and gallery promotions.

Note: VSOA must seek a scholarship for each semester for needy children to cover costs. If a child is only sponsored for one semester, they will want to come back and continue with VSOA. We encourage our donors to continue to sponsor the same child for at least a year or longer and follow their progress. We offer our full year donors a giclee of their favorite student work and website recognition.
